LEADERSHIP ACADEMY 2021/2022

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

Leadership Academy Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a licensed mental health professional, financial professional, or lawyer (or as designated in the IACP Minimum Requirement for Professionals)
- Be a member of a Collaborative Practice Group (or provide an explanation for not being involved in a practice group)
- Have completed an Introductory Collaborative Training that meets IACP Standards
- Have leadership experience of some kind, not specifically in the Collaborative Community
- Be a member of the IACP or be willing to join the IACP if selected for the Academy
- Submit 3 letters of recommendation from any group in which they had leadership experience, including one from a leader in your practice group (if you have a practice group), and one from outside your practice group
- Have sufficient fluency in English to be an active participant or have a strategy to enable active participation
- Be willing to be flexible with scheduling video conferences and potentially meet in the middle of the night in order to maximize participation for a global group.
- Be willing to commit to equity and inclusion as guiding principles of their leadership style
- If selected, pay the registration fee, including the practice group contribution (limited scholarships available)

Leadership Academy Applicants must commit to the following:

- Attend the 2021 Forum in San Diego, CA (Oct. 27-31, 2021) and the 2022 Forum in Orlando, FL (Oct. 27-30, 2022) (limited scholarships may be available)
- Attend the Leadership Academy Retreat in between Forums (limited financial assistance may be available, dates and location to be determined)
- Attend Leadership Academy webinars (may be held quarterly, bi-monthly, or monthly), with active, on-camera participation
- Present a workshop at the 2022 Forum or an IACP webinar
- Contribute a unique blog or unique newsletter article to your practice group, if any
- Contribute a unique submission to the IACP blog or the *Collaborative Review*, demonstrating how they integrated their learning from the Leadership Academy
- Commit to apply to be on an IACP Committee upon graduation
- Apply for a practice group or regional leadership role (i.e., practice group or statewide/provincewide board, chair of a practice group or statewide/provincewide committee, etc.) by the end of the Leadership Academy
