  - Review facts,
  - How would you design a collab process to help this family?
  - How would you ensure process build in the features of a successful MC?
  - Develop questions to prompt discussion,
- 7. With participants, build what would an <u>ideal collab process</u> look like? (Big Flip chart/Sticky Notes) (15 minutes)
- 8. Discussion are participation agreements useful? Why/why not? (5 minutes) if you use a PA, what would you include or take out from the PA? Would you adapt your retainer agreement? Refer to Expectations in Collaborative Marriage Contract Negotiation.
- 9. Exit poll how many now see the value in a full team collaborative approach and will consider in the future? (5 minutes)
- 10. Summary and any Q and A's
